It feels like all different things in nature, all mixed together, and it's different every day.



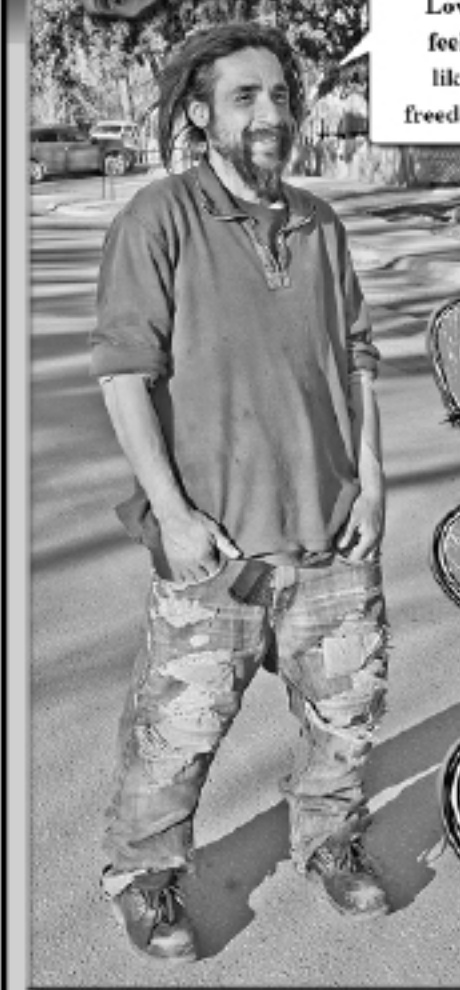
Barbara Joy Vandenberg
